Brush substrate to remove all dust & cobwebs.

Application:

Do not dilute, product is ready for application by airless spray.

Apply Elite Blackout onto substrate overlapping 50% on each pass.

Use Airless Spray with tip size .013 to .015

Spray onto all substrates contained in ceiling at the same time.

Completion;

On completion leave area for 20 mins to let overspray settle. Clean & remove all materials & plant from working area. Remove all masking and rubbish and brush up any overspray.

Inspect the area and leave area ready for re-occupation.
